## **BREAKING: FEC Complaint Alleges Paul Chabot Violated Federal Election Law**

Tea-Party Republican accused of "raiding his children's savings" to fund his dishonest campaign

Tea-Party Republican candidate Paul Chabot is on the hot seat again. On the heels of a <u>complaint</u> that accused Chabot of several Ethics violations, an even more damaging complaint has just been filed against the perennial candidate. Howard Morris, a Rancho Cucamonga resident, filed the complaint with the Federal Election Commission (FEC). It accuses Chabot of appearing to have "raided his children's savings in order to make an excessive loan to his campaign, and then misreported the source of those funds." The origin of this mysterious \$50,000 loan has been causing Chabot headaches since an <u>article</u> in the *Press-Enterprise* exposed in detail the full scope of his suspicious financial disclosures.

"As a voter and someone who cares deeply about our community, I want Paul Chabot to be held accountable for his actions," said Howard Morris. "We have a right to know if he's violating the law, and I expect him to give us the truth."

"Just when we thought things couldn't get any worse, it's become clear that Paul Chabot has virtually no interest in being honest and transparent with Inland Empire voters," said Chris Robles, Chair of the San Bernardino County Democratic Party. "This latest accusation should be a wake-up call to voters that Chabot is unfit to represent California's 31st Congressional District."

Chabot has refused to answer any questions stemming from last week's Ethics complaint or the *Press-Enterprise* article. After getting beat by Democrat Pete Aguilar in 2014, Chabot is challenging Aguilar again.
